- In the morning children from 3rd Class upwards should be dropped to the school yard and escorted across the road.
- Children may enter the school yard from 9am. Each class has a clearly marked designated area where the children must stand. Staff will escort the children to their room making sure they all sanitise their hands before entering.
- Children who show any signs of the symptoms of Covid-19 will be brought to a designated isolation room and observed there until a parent or nominated person arrives to take them home. Any siblings must also be taken home at this point.

- Break times will be staggered with three small breaks and three lunch breaks. Children in the same class may play together but there will be no mingling between classes.
- There will be no homework given until the week starting Monday September 7th.
- For the time being all the children will be taking home is their lunchbox and their hygiene kit.
 These should both be cleaned each evening.
- At home time children will be left out in an orderly manner to avoid any build up at the gates.
 Children travelling on the bus and children collecting siblings will be left out first. Please be patient as dismissing the children may take a few minutes while we are getting used to the new system.
